RULES:

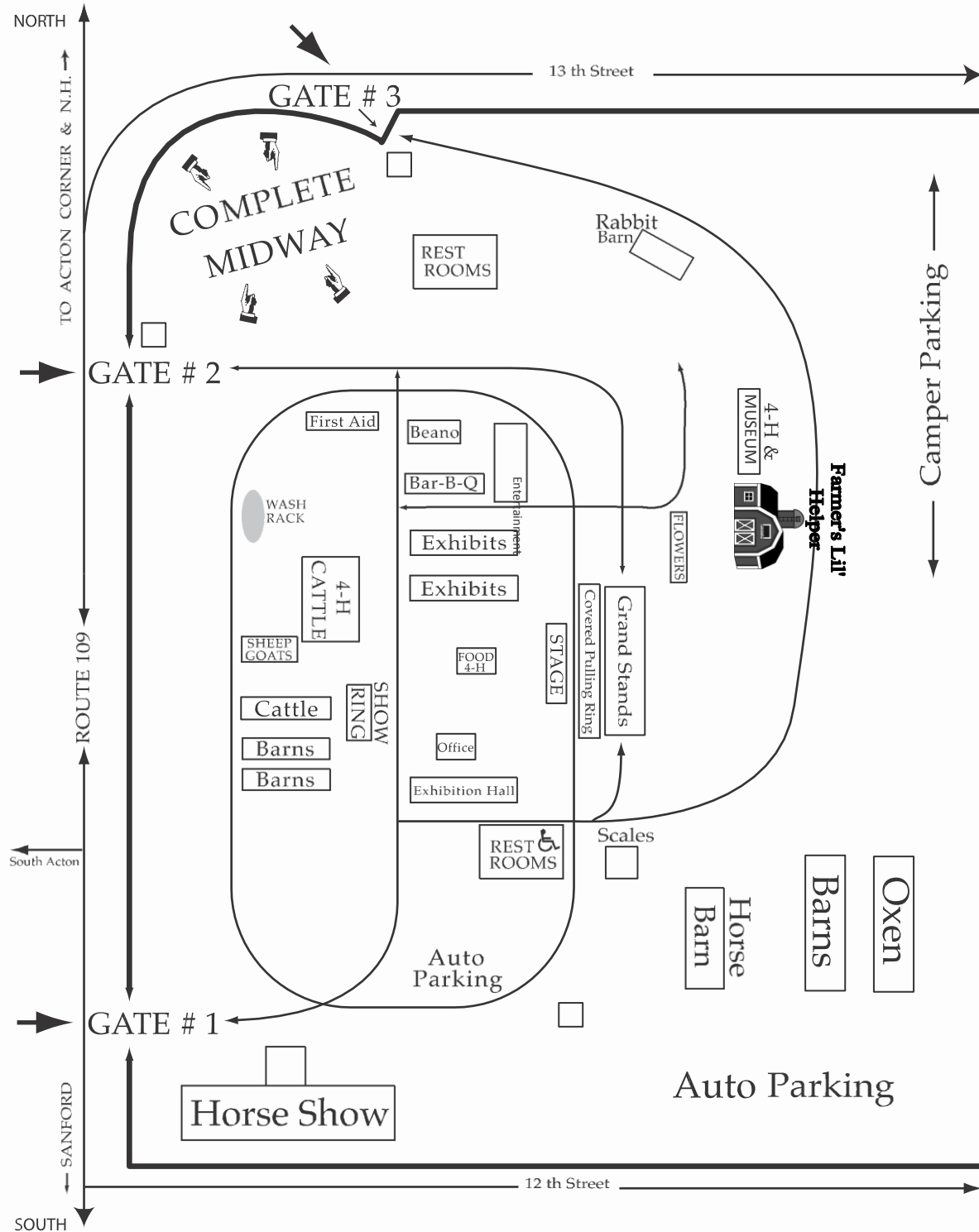
