FRIDAY wristbands will be sold from 12 noon to 4 PM entitling the wearer to ride from noon until 5 PM.

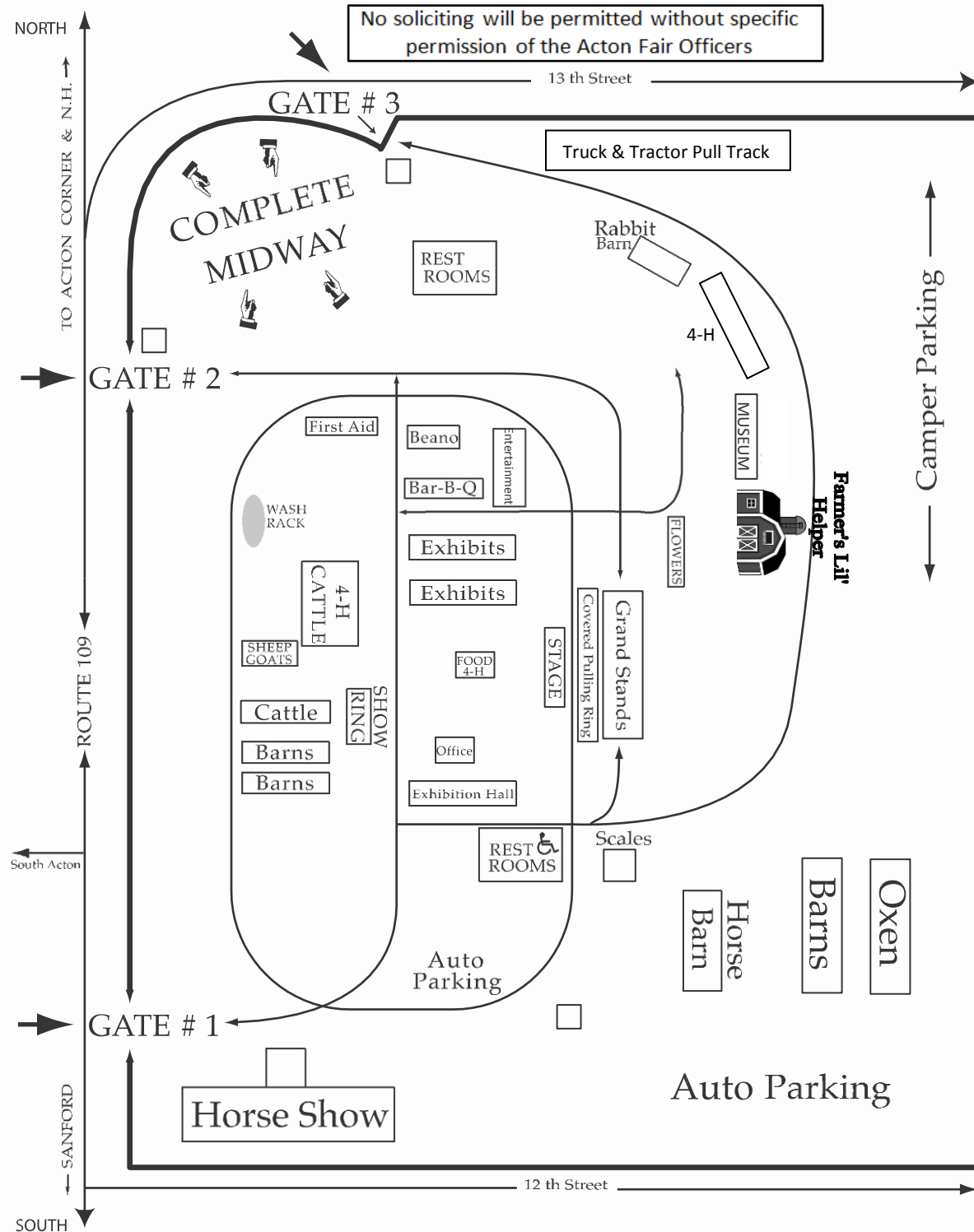
SUNDAY wristbands will be sold from opening until 3 PM allowing you to ride until the fair closes at 6 PM.

Good as long as space is available

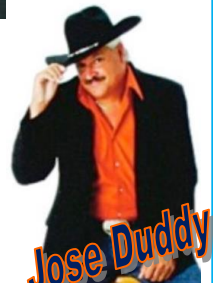
